Caro	Want parks to have surveillance to prevent car break ins
Cross Glen	I see green parks as one of the ways that stops fires that we in Kelowna also need to prepare for. If the grass is brown in most of the parks, there is a great place for grass fires to start and that could lead to more serious fires. I do believe that many parks are overwatered though, the ones in our area are often slushy from too much water.
Cross Glen	I feel that there must be a way in which we can water for shorter periods of time and still keep our parks green. Time of day has a lot to do with our watering too.
Hartman	I do my best saving water: Don't let water run when brushing teeth, short showers, we got rid of a lot of grass in our yard and replaced it with a lot of rocks and shrubs
Hartman	We use our water carefully and respectfully
Hartman	We do not need super green golf courses
Hartman	If there is a water shortage it is understandable.
Hartman	We don't waste water (watering the driveway, letting tap run while brushing teeth etc) We are concerned about over population of the valley. Thus increasing the need to worry if we have enough water.
Hartman	The parks certainly don't need to be watered as often as they are. It would conserve water for human consumption. People can enjoy parks that aren't necessarily always green.
Jewel	It is a concern- why put green grass instead of putting in dry landscaping
Jewel	We do what we can to save water but like green grass and have a family, laundry,...
Jewel	I conserve water around the house but a park like that is used by many kids in the area for running games and free play, so it must be in good condition. The green areas are what kettle valley is all about, so you can't change into gardens that can't be played in. They sacrificed lawn space for many homes in order to have green space, so many of the private homes are reducing water usage and the parks are the only green spaces.\
Millard Glen	I only conserve water when there is a water shortage. Not just using less water for an idealism.

Providence	we have increased our own conservation by better participation (IE-better and thicker water retention soils and mulching)
Sonora	With the number of ppl moving here will our water supply keep up?

Sonora	The park was a major factor in our decision to purchase in area, used visually by everyone. If not maintained, it will become an eyesore and property values will decline.
Sonora	I do think we have all kinds of water if ppl would use it conservatively.
Sonora	We all live in Kelowna and its neighborhoods because its beautiful, oiur tourists come here for the same reason. We hav a big lake and plentiful snowfall on our maountains. I'd like to see irrigation systems mandatory for residents. Some abuse the water. Maybe limit number of hours a day to water, etc.
Sumac	I would prefer stricter restrictions on residential lawns. City lawns should be for us all to enjoy. My back yard can go brown
Sumac	If watering was a problem then we should look at development that keeps going on in Kelowna and ensure there is enuf water before we get in a bind. Does the city really want a brown city where only the rich can afford to water and have nice yards?
Sumac	Cause this is one of the vital elements of the living beings.
Wigglesworth	It is important during hot dry times, but we need green space. Why have parks if we can't play in them because the grass is horrible.
Wigglesworth	Conservation could start in mountain lakes, better dams and more supervision
Wigglesworth	I practice water conservation in my yard. I have taken a xerscape course offered gy Gwen Steele (PRC), I do see a huge contradiction developing, however. We are told to conserve water yet the agricultural sprinkler nearby are always sprinkling and golf courses are not brown. So who are we saving water for? I would like to see a community where all stakeholders to the water are conserving equally. It does not appear so at the present.
Winslow	Winslow park is now 50% weeds so why bother having any grass? The park has deteriorated in appearance and upkeep the past few years; it is now very un-inviting! It appears to be the most neglected park in kettle valley. We are definitely for water conservation, but general neglect and poor maintenance are unacceptable.

Park name	14. Any other comments about water conservation or how the parks department or the city could do more to conserve water?
Caro	Water like I do, every second day for 20 minutes per zone.
Caro	What are we paying these people to do? Include water conservation as part of job description.
Caro	I was surprised that no one realized that the irrigation system was working during the afternoon for several weeks this spring and summer
Caro	We have parties at night (in the park), put the sprinklers on at night to get rid of the partiers. Today the sprinklers were on in afternoon when temp. 38 degrees. No thought goes into this. We have phoned RCMP about problem and bylaws. Simple solution to problem- water at night, get rid of partiers, have green grass.
Caro	Water less frequently and for shorter cycles
Caro	Should not cost tax payers more to save water and have dead grass. Why not take the money it cost for this survey and others to make sure that the city parks are more efficient without water wastage and dead grass
Caro	Grass and parks should be allowed to go brown to conserve water with 2 exceptions. 1)intensive sports activities, 2) where brown grass causes a fire hazard. Caro park falls under the category of fire hazard and it is increased by night time parties. One cigarette discarded could cause a large fire and spread to houses. For this reason Caro Park must be kept green.
Caro	Control development. Caro park unfortunately is a hang out for large numbers of teenagers late at night. Smoking, drug dealing and alcohol consumption. If grass is allowed to dry up and turn brown then fire hazard concern will go up.
Caro	Water park after 10pm for conservation and also to discourage vandalism and partying in the park.
Caro	Less grass more drought resistant plants
Cross Glen	Time of day watering, length of time watering, not watering when it is not raining, (have a system in which the sprinkler system ceases when it is storming) more water efficient plants sounds like an excellent plan. We live in a beautiful city and I don't feel that we should be penalized with another tax to keep it beautiful.
Cross Glen	It would be helpful if the underground sprinklers went off at night instead of in the middle of the afternoon. That would conserve a fair bit of water. Also many are overwatered and still wet in the middle of the afternoon. They could use less water and still be green.
Hartman	Water conservation starts with each and every person at home.
Hartman	Hartman road is continuously being watered by orchardists that have not set up their sprinklers properly. This results in more frequent car washes from vehicles getting dirty from sprinklers and mud on the road. This compounds water waste. (Regarding tax increases) But why should they increase taxes? Stop watering roads, ie between Reeds corner, McCurdy road, center lanectc etc. This is city wasting water.
Hartman	Put water meters in homes
Hartman	Spread or plant in water retaining soil.
Hartman	Water in early morning between 4-7 am
Hartman	Less grass along roadways. Instead use drought tolerant plants and trees.
Hartman	Water is being wasted by many orchards. Hartman hill is so bad at times, water is running down the road on a sunny day. Also McKenzie road orchards are wasting water all the time.
Hartman	I think the city should of though about it before they allowed tower ranch with the golf course, which will take a large amount of water to keep green. Or have they decided to let go brown? Let them pay for the water they'll be able to afford it, since only the rich will be able to live there. Im getting tired of hearing about water saving when you allow more homes and golf courses to be built. You are not thinking about the future, all you have is taxes on the brain!

Hartman	I just hope that other parks in the city are being questioned the same. It's nice of a subdivision to just let the grass go brown. I do like your ideas in question and would be very supportive to that option.
Hartman	Try turning off underground sprinklers when it rains for days.
Hartman	I have noticed the grass being more brown this year as opposed to other years. It is not bad now.
Hartman	Slow down City growth and we'll be just fine! The park has only been poor quality this year. Other years it has been just fine.
Jewel	We live by a LAKE is there not a way to fix this conservation problem? Purchased home on park to enjoy and be in park and see green in front of steps, we would be very upset to see brown grass like it is now
Jewel	A tax increase will never happen, I mean lower taxes will always go up no matter what
Jewel	The park this year is already brown and obviously is not getting enough water already. So the park is being underused because of the parks state.
Jewel	It is too expensive, maybe some of jewel park could be paved for tennis courts, that would reduce the water needs. If this were done at one end it could still be used for walking, playing and picnics, sports.
Jewel	Have not lived in Kelowna long enuf.
Jewel	There are ways to conserve water without tax increases, stop wasting water cleaning streets, sweepers yes but you don't need water. Water parks for children are not necessary. People (taxpayers with homes) who leave their sprinklers on for hours with water flowing down the street should be fined. Tax per use of water (metered).
Newport Glen	I personally feel the parks division does an excellent job keeping all parks functioning and aesthetically attractive and welcoming. Dollars already invested in parks have been committed over time for all the right reasons. I would find it wrong to see them turn to acres of deserts like plots. Summer is when families can enjoy all parks including Newport park. Why have them useless and unappealing to families when most needed? Lets find other ways than having parks rendered useless. Looks like it would have long term water conservation benefits.
Newport Glen	The initial investment start up costs for synthetic turf might be high, but in the long run water usage and costs, maintenance costs and upkeep would be greatly reduced.
Newport Glen	I personally have changed our landscaping to the more drought tolerant for example, rockeries and less lawn. We use less at home, please don't let our parks suffer. Thanks, Gordon Ridgewell. He has called but would like to discuss this in more detail, 861-9067
Newport Glen	Less irrigation might conserve water but the grass will look ugly and it will damage the image of the neighborhood. It might a good idea to change the park. Have less grass and more natural areas, drought tolerating plants. Brown grass gives the image of a very neglected park.
Newport Glen	If you are saving resources and power to fund these resources, let those funds pay for change. Our parks and public places need to be green for our tourist dollars. The tax paying public need green places to visit. That is why we have parks. We need green grass to offset apartment living and calm our souls. If allowed to go natural or brown, our parks and public areas become fire hazards...remember 2003.
Newport Glen	Agree with note at bottom.
Newport Glen	By using drought tolerant grass was the soil prepared under the grass to ensure moisture retention?
Newport Glen	Communicating like this is useful, Marketing your intentions to city dwellers.
Providence	Make parks out of indigenous vegetation so less irrigation is needed
Providence	Try watering at night instead of the the middle of a hot afternoon (you lose a lot to evaporation), check sprinkler systems properly 3-4 times a season to ensure they are watering properly, do not water road, etc.

Providence	I agree with planting other vegetation that needs less water but if there is grass it should be kept in a healthy green state
Providence	Have parks with plants that take little water but green parks a must. Why have ppl paid to cut grass when it isn't growing, the weeds are. There is no point in having grass parks where it hurts your feet to walk on. At times they get so dry they could burn.
Providence	Fix the heads, have someone every now and again to check. I leave for work at the airport at 4:50 am and the water wasted at Gordon, Benvoulin and Hwy 97 is unbelievable. I know your busy and short staffed but I see I have a leak to fix in or around the house, I have to fix it. Do the best you can with what you have. Thanks.
Providence	More trees for shade
Providence	More field turf fields for softball. It is ridiculous to always put sand on playing fields. We live in a desert, we do not have drainage issues in most cases. The sand and improper watering has ruined many playing fields. They are in brutal shape.
Providence	Less watering, a bit of brown is fine but should not be a fire hazard.
Providence	Less grass, more tolerant plants more trees for shade.
Providence	I have to frequently adjust my sprinkler system at home throughout the summer months. The parks department must do the same.
Providence	Use drought resistant grass varieties like by the library if suitable for usage. Use moisture detectors, there was significant rainfall in the summer were unnecessarily going full-blast. Don't cut lawn in parks so short, long turf maintains moisture better. There have been inconsistent watering practices in the summer that have led to unnecessary water usage.
Providence	Why do the parks department plant turf and beautiful plants if in a year or two. Stop watering them regularly. Makes our neighboring properties in our community look terrible.
Providence	If golf courses can be green then so can our parks. Conserve water by limiting population growth. Other jurisdictions have limited or halted growth, why can't we?
Providence	Rain sensors for irrigation systems. Better monitoring of existing systems, ensure sidewalks, etc are not being irrigated, don't irrigate just after it rains. More xeriscaping. Kettle valley houses typically have smaller lots, therefore the public green spaces are highly utilized and should be maintained. Small children do not like to play on dry, prickly grass. As we are trying to encourage children to be more active, this should be taken into consideration.
Providence	Reference to question 13: however if implemented well, water conservation would save money in the long term [if taxes were increased]
Providence	Gray water treatment for irrigation of parks, etc. Any park I have seen planted uses poor soils and too thin layers with much of Kelowna on sand base makes for extremely poor water retention.
Providence	The parks in Kettle Valley in general are poorly maintained
Sonora	Parks could conserve more water by getting rid of unnecessary green areas
Sonora	Reduce overspray and run-off, soccer fields should be kept green
Sonora	You are doing a good job
Sonora	Reduce watering of grass by 30%, water trees and shrubs on regular basis.
Sonora	Create a large reservoir by damming mission creek
Sonora	Those set on timers (all???) be changed in cooler weather or not run as long
Sonora	I don't think we should deprive children of places to play or seniors a green place to enjoy leisure time. This park is used a lot and it keeps the children off the busy street, where else can they play? Think about developers putting in pools and planting trees on their rooftops, stop people from watering in middle of day, the more ppl we bring into our city the more water it takes no matter if its a highrise or a home. Planting flowers and trees on streets, just let our children have space. As a tax payer is important to keep area looking nice as is for other areas of city. Ppl take pride in their yards so let us keep it that way. The water they have to spray on streets is the problem, not the parks.
Sonora	Better control of water going south of penticton, less watering of golf courses.

Sonora	I see a lot of waste in orchards instead of spraying couldn't they use a drip system
Sonora	Parks should not be the first priority rather private clubs, golf courses, etc. Public parks important for well-being.
Sonora	Can watering parks be on a sensitivity wet dry indicator so they are not watered when they are raining.
Sonora	The city should water at night like we do, conserving water should result in a tax decrease.
Sonora	Stop watering golf courses more and xeriscape areas with drought tolerant plants. Use different materials for playing surfaces and try alternatives etc. Follow same outlines as residents, for example watering days and times etc.
Sonora	They should only be watered every two days.
Sonora	Please keep them green and looking like parks. If not perhaps they could be put to other uses (Jack May, 1547 Sonora Dr.)
Sonora	I also see a lot of older swimming pools drained into storm sewers.
Sonora	Develop future parks with smaller open space and more water hearty plants. Parks need to be green more than residences. We had some green space. Thans for asking, Stan Walt.
Sonora	In general, the maintenance of Sonora park is excellent, except weeds are starting to take over the park.
Sonora	You cannot play sports on a field of mud. Either have a park or don't. If you don't water the grass you will have a field of weeds.
Sumac	Stricter residential watering, my neighbor waters all day every day. I would rather use that water on city parks for us all.
Sumac	I see a lot of grassy blvds that are poorly maintained, for example grass not cut enough, weeds, etc. These areas are irrigated and I don't feel the cost, the poor upkeep by near by residents werent keeping these areas unless the city looks after them or properly enforces that they are looked after. Lay some tickets on these lazy S.O.B's and maybe things will change. These are areas that are possibly areas to conserve water on.
Sumac	We already pay enuf taxes, use my share from the mission pool. There are quite often ppl at sumac park at dusk and late nite (drinking, smoking????). If the grass were allowed to go brown this would be a fire hazard. We back onto the park and would have that fire hazard too close for comfort.
Sumac	There are ways to conserve water, why should we pay more tax if the job is done properly. Why not water parks every 2nd-3rd day instead of everyday. Keep grass longer so the moisture keeps grass greener.
Sumac	How will tax increases conserve water?
Sumac	Yes, have no more golf courses built. If you let our parks go brown because of water shortage then do not allow a golf coursebe built up such as the Tower Ranch which will draw a lot of water and also allowing these sub divisions being built.
Sumac	Using reclaimed water could be one part of the solution to conserve water
Wigglesworth	Alternate days of watering
Wigglesworth	Cut backs are required by everyone in these dry months including parks but they should be maintained enough to keep appealing to the neighborhood and tourism
Wigglesworth	Get rid of all illigal suites! They do not pay for extra water and they use a lot of water or give a cut rate to legal ones.
Wigglesworth	There are so many other ways to save water like setting the automatic systems to water when its raining. Making sure the water is actually going on the grass and not on the road. Don't over water so there is puddles all over the place. Letting the grass go brown is also an extreem fire hazard.
Wigglesworth	Use more rocks, etc for parts of landscape. Water only at night and not during the day. Fine people who leave water on all day when it is hot outside. Water less but keep grass green still. The more you water the more grass wants water.

Wigglesworth	I have heard that clover stays green but requires much less water. Do not know if this is true or not. (Use instead of turf in some areas)
Wigglesworth	Irrigate smart (not on rainy days), improve equipment and control, the tools are available, water earlier than present. 2-3 am instead of 4-5 am. I have seen lots of stress early this year.
Wigglesworth	Water a few minutes less everyday will help conserve water
Wigglesworth	Give fines (bylaw?) to people who water in the heat of the day
Winslow	Bought house b/c of park, old and don't drive so walk to park. If changes made to park might devalue house, please do not change appearance of park and keep it watered.
Winslow	More natural, rocky areas and drought tolerant plants. Do not neces. Need grass everywhere but keep things landscaped and presentable
Winslow	The park is already in a terrible mess which I have the pleasure of looking at thru my windows! (sarcastic)
Winslow	Sprinklers should run during late evening or morning, not during day. The grass is in a deplorable state, I would have phoned today (july 17) but note that sprinklers were on today presumably in response to other complaints
Winslow	Restrict homeowner use- the amount people use in irrigation are ridiculous. Sidewalks are soaks, pools forming on road, etc.
Winslow	Stop watering during midday
Winslow	I noticed that winslow park is watered btwn 8am-9pm, it is already hot and sunny at this time. I would suggest that sprinklers come on late Pm or early Am- we could conserve water and have green grass.
Winslow	We pay enough taxes- figure out how to conserve water with your current budget.
Winslow	Watering schedules giving minimal watering for maximum effect. Grass should be moderately green, not brown or dead, no overfertilizing requiring increased water needs. Sprinkler heads adjusted to not waste water on road and sidewalks. Grass length tidy, but not shaggy.
Winslow	Having beautiful parks is part of what makes Kelowna beautiful. It is very important! I know that saving water is important too, so drought tolerant parks are a great idea. There are still many people/businesses who water too often and midday. Attack them before letting the parks die. Winslow park looks horrible this summer. The grass is outnumbered by weeds- definate signs of stress.
Winslow	In my opinion, if you decide to plant grass in a park, it should be kept green. However I feel the number of parks using grass should be dramatically dregulated. Perhaps 1 in 3 Kettle valley parks could be grass wile others could be xeriscaped or left in a natural state with walking paths. I rarely see the park grass used for play etc. so we really don't need so much of it. With more xeriscaping and less grass we could keep the grass green and save water at the same time.
